Even a local college visit makes college feel real. Walk around, grab lunch, ask questions.

Run a net price calculator

Pick a dream school and run its net price calculator together. The real number is often far below the sticker price.

Plan a balanced junior schedule

Junior year is the big one. Help your student choose challenging but realistic courses.

Start an activity log

Keep a running list of activities, roles, and accomplishments. It makes applications far easier later.

A job, internship, program, or volunteering builds skills and direction before junior year.
